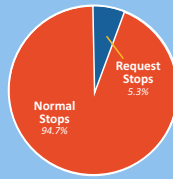


The 135 Request Stops in Great Britain



England - 55

(Over one third of these are in Devon and Cornwall)

Wales - 61

(Just under one third of these are on the Heart of Wales line)

Scotland - 19

* Stations with special rules

Bearley / Claverdon

All Chiltern Railway services stop at this station, it is the one early morning West Midlands Railway service that only stops upon request.

Ardlui / Roy Bridge

All local Scotrail services stop at Ardlui and Roy Bridge but the Caledonian Sleeper service only stops upon request.

Builth Road

During the Royal Welsh Show in July of every year, extra services run to Builth Road. These always stop, and are not request services.

One direction only request stops

Some stations are request stops in *one direction only* due to a level crossing at that station - when the train stops at these stations for the crew to manually operate the crossing, it is not a request stop in that direction. If the station is *after* the level crossing, it is a request stop.

Stations that are request stops in the *Southbound direction only*
Ammanford, Bucknall, Dolau, Llanwrda, Llangadog, Llanybyddie.

Stations that are request stops in the *Northbound direction only*
Ffairfach, Tal-y-Cafn.

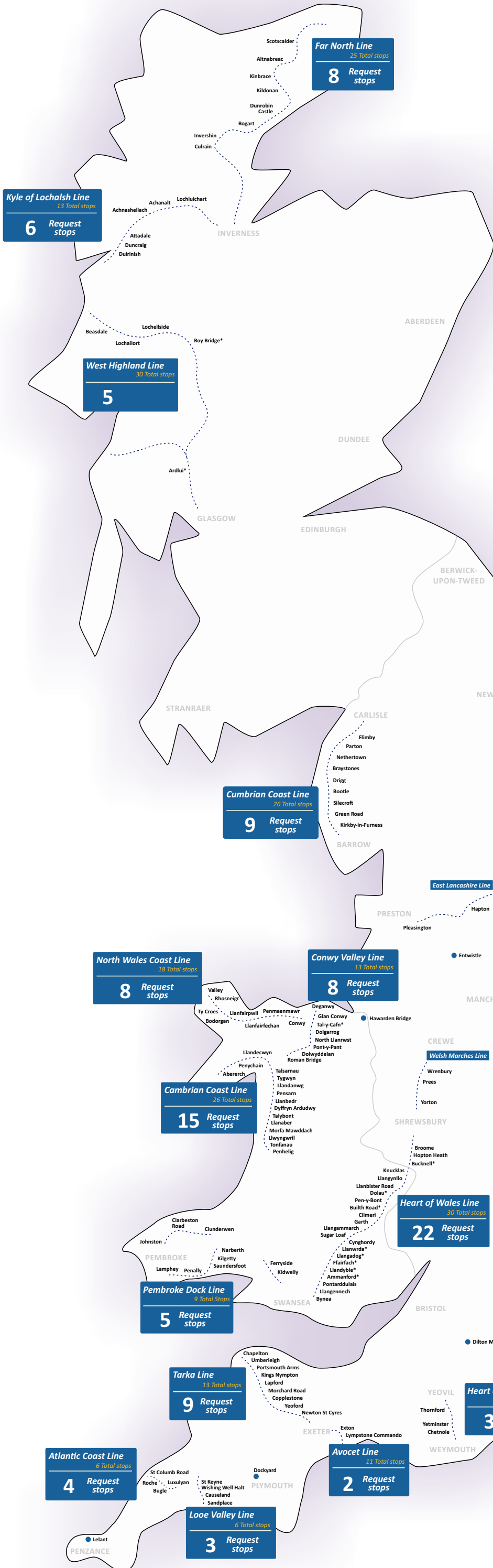
